Gas Energy Australia - Workshop - LPG in hospitality

On Wednesday 10th August GAMAA Executive Councilors Paul Baini and Ross Jamieson were invited to attend a workshop hosted by Gas Energy Australia, guests also included Michele Stromquist, Peter Beacham and Tim Owen from Safework NSW.

Items that were discussed were the use of Yum Cha steam trolleys, a subject of a gas safety alert from Department of Natural Resources and Mines (QLD). Similar issues have been identified in NSW with no approved product and inappropriate storage of LPG gas cylinders.

The use of area heaters within NSW was also discussed along with the ongoing issue of the misuse of "lunchbox cookers", there is potential for action from NSW on lunchbox cookers in the near future.

Both Paul and Ross were active contributors to the discussions across all discussion points. Further action on the Yum Cha steam trolleys whilst something that could not be solved during the meeting it was suggested that further work should be done in AG-001.
