## Standard Australia Update

Public comment is now open for the following new drafts:

AS 3645            Essential requirements for gas equipment  
AS 5263.1.4      Gas appliances – Radiant gas heaters

The key change to AS 3645 is to now call up the 5263 suite of Standards. This will impact industry once published as manufacturers will be required to migrate their certifications from the old Standard to the new 5263 Standard where available.

AS5263.1.4 has resulted in the combining of AS 4565-2004 and AS 4643-2007 into a single Standard.

GAMAA requests that members take the time to actually read both these Standards and make Public Comment where appropriate as a significant amount of time and effort has been made by your representatives on the AG-001 committee.
