#### **GEA Safe+Connects - POL Connections**

On Friday 25 November Mr Tony Say, Chief Executive Officer of CEM International Pty Ltd and Gas Energy Australia Board of Directors and Treasurer and Mr Darryl Ramm, Manager Technical Development from Gas Energy Australia met with the GAMAA Executive Council to brief them on the Safe+Connect project.

The Safe+Connect project is reviewing the safeness of the type 21 (POL) connection used on 4.5 and 9kg gas cylinders supplying portable gas appliances such as BBQ and area heaters. The project team headed by Darryl Ramm is in the process of capturing robust current data and looking at previous reports and evidence both in Australia and overseas.

The briefing to GAMAA is part of an ongoing process of keeping stakeholders informed and brought GAMAA Exec Council members up to speed on the project so far and asked for support in gathering research and reports on the safeness of the current POL connection.

GAMAA and GEA will remain closely engaged on this important project and GAMAA members will be updated as more information comes to hand.

The Federal Government's 2017 review of its approach to climate change is an opportunity to develop a comprehensive long-term strategy to transition Australia to a zero emission energy sector in decades to come, the Clean Energy Council said after the release of the review's terms of reference today.

"Long-term renewable energy policy is essential to provide investment signals that will continue to attract capital from both local and international investors. The majority of Australians support the shift towards renewable energy, and the rapidly-falling cost of both renewables and storage makes these technologies an obvious choice to reduce emissions in the energy sector.

"While renewable energy is the lowest-cost type of energy which can be built today, it is competing against old coal-fired power plants which were built by taxpayers many decades ago. While many of these will close in the decades to come, a national energy strategy is needed to minimise the impact on local communities, power prices and energy security.
