Face Coverings for All Victorians and New Obligation to Report COVID-19 Diagnosis

Ai Group Member Advice 30 July 2020

The Victorian Government has announced a number of COVID-19 responses that may impact your employees and business:

1. From 11:59 pm on Sunday 2 August 2020, a face covering will be mandatory whenever a person leaves home, no matter where they live in Victoria.
2. From 11:59 pm tonight, Thursday 30 July 2020, in the local government areas of Colac-Otway, Greater Geelong, Surf Coast, Moorabool, Golden Plains, and the Borough of Queenscliff, people will no longer be able to visit people or have visitors at their home.
3. New regulations require an employer to notify WorkSafe immediately they become aware that an employee or contractor has tested positive for COVID-19 and has been in the workplace within the infectious period.
4. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has finally released guidance for cleaners, business owners and managers about how to clean and disinfect after a COVID-19 case in the workplace.

The mandatory wearing of face coverings by all Victorians from Sunday night extends the same restrictions and exemptions that currently apply to the metropolitan Melbourne and Mitchell Shire. A [COVID-19 Face Mask Fact Sheet](#) is available on our website.

An employer is now required to report to WorkSafe when they become aware that an employee or contractor has received a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis and attended the workplace within their "infectious period". It does not matter where the infection was caught. A [Member Advice 062/20](#) dated 29 July 2020 has been issued.
